Student Engagement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Satisfaction:</b> 69% reports their student enjoys SO, and 68% their student more motivated to learn.</li> <li>- <b>Intercessions:</b> 80% understand the importance of Intercessions and attendance from their student.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>=&gt; Attendance Rate</li> </ul>
6. School Climate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Safe Climate:</b> Only 67% mentions SO provides a safe school climate and 69% agrees that the staff guides students in becoming respectful members of the community (through social inclusion).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>=&gt; Safe Climate Activities</li> </ul>
3. Parent Involvement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Welcome:</b> 85% feels welcome when at Silver Oak.</li> <li>- <b>Power School:</b> 81% indicated access to Power School, only 47% are using it often or regularly.</li> <li>- <b>Communication:</b> 75% of parents receive regular information of the different activities.</li> <li>- <b>Feedbacks:</b> 80% agrees parents are able to provide suggestions/ideas to make the school better.</li> <li>- <b>Spanish:</b> 88% acknowledges that Silver Oak emphasizes Spanish communication.</li> <li>- <b>Partner:</b> 85% notices that SO sees parents as important partners in their student's education.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>=&gt; Parents Involvement (conferences, Educational meetings, Power School, emails)</li> <li>=&gt; Parents Volunteerism (work days, field trips, fundraisers)</li> </ul>
