

SOHS Student Action Committee

The first meeting of the SOHS Student Action Committee was held on Wednesday, November 16th. Approximately twenty (20) students, from all grade levels, attended. Three (3) faculty members participated as well. The committee accomplished the following. They...

- affirmed that committee meetings were open at any time, to any students, and that all students were free to participate in any committee event, whether or not they attended the meetings;
- reviewed the Conduct Policy in the "Family Handbook" that required written parental permission to leave campus during the school day;
- compiled a list of political action causes/movements to support (local, national and international);
- agreed to research all aspects of each cause/movement in order to best prioritize the committee's action:
- acknowledged that there were differences in opinion amongst the committee members and agreed that there could be "subcommittees" within the larger group, so that the members could work on more than one cause at a time;
- set our next meeting for Wednesday, November 30th.
