How is SOHS a "Montessori college prep school"?

The "Montessori high school" model requires that students...

- complete a comprehensive liberal arts program...four years in each core subject matter
- work collaboratively (as members of a work group) in each subject matter
- participate in a career path internship and apply to at least three colleges
- complete two hundred (200) hours of Community Service
- successfully complete their "Self-Construction" courses (responsibility/global stewardship)

The "college prep" model requires that...

- all courses are University of California A-G "articulated" (reviewed and approved)
- students attain mastery (no less than a C-) in each course
- the school is WASC accredited
- each core curricular class meets for 64 hours per semester
