

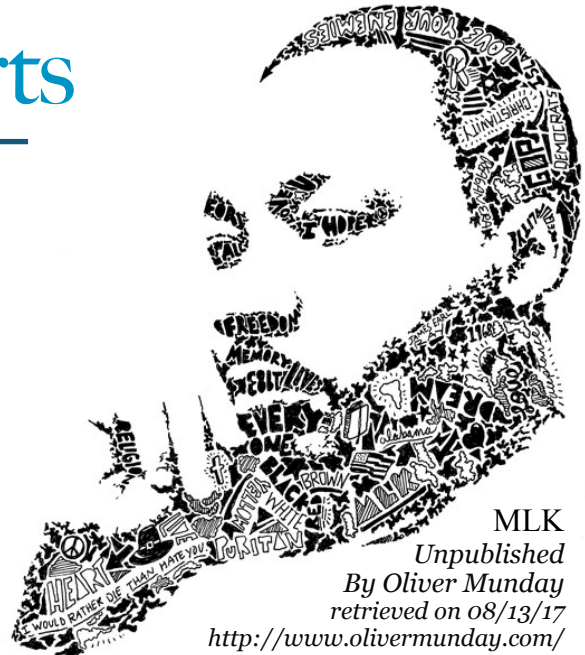

Overview -

What is Digital Media Arts and why do I need to know it?
