Subject: Spanish 2 Grade Level: 9-10

Essential understanding:

Verbs are the driving force of language expression. In Spanish, the verb is conjugated and changed based on the pronouns involved in the action being expressed.

Overview:

Now that you dominate a basic knowledge of Spanish and the use of verb tenses, you are ready to start the next level. In Spanish 2, you will focus on developing and forming more complex thoughts and sentences, writing grammatically correct Spanish, and reading for understanding. This quarter we will focus on the basic rules for conjugating regular verbs and memorizing the conjugation of important irregular verbs. We are a STEAM School (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math); therefore, be prepared to incorporate your knowledge of STEAM in class. Please, also make sure your laptop is fully charged and ready to be used daily in our classroom. Your interactive notebook is where you will document your "follow-up" work and your creative study methods. Remember that you have many choices for completing an activity, practicing a concept from a lesson and demonstrating knowledge of any lesson given. Please refer to the handout you pasted in your notebook for some ideas on those choices. Most importantly, make sure you ask questions when something is not clear to you. **Spanish will be spoken in class 99.9% of the time.**
