# Standardized Testing @ SOHS

To support all of our students as they navigate our high stakes standardized testing culture, the Faculty has designed a program that will prepare students for the test without "teaching to the test". To that end we are incorporating the following strategies in our curriculum...

- SBAC and SAT formatted warm-ups, using laptops, in all core subject areas;
- Fall Interim SBAC testing for Evaluation and Practice; and
- SAT and SBAC formatted questions imbedded in all subject areas.

- Friday, October 26<sup>th</sup> marks the end of the first quarter here at Silver Oak High School.
