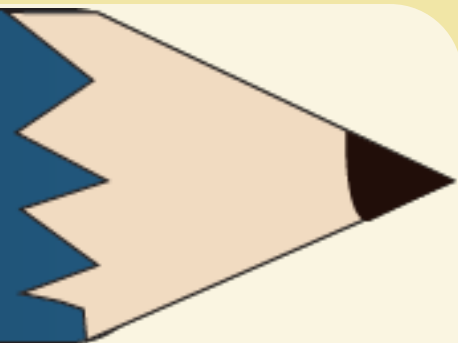


# SOHS News
