

The Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) replaces revenue limits and eliminates most categorical program funding formulas with the <u>intent of allowing the local stakeholders to have significant discretion to make the decisions that best meet the needs of the students in the LEA.</u>

The Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) is the procedure for <u>including local stake holders in the decision making process</u> and for monitoring and evaluating the district's progress in achieving the planned student outcomes.

Our 2018-2019 LCAP parent surveys will be distributed on 4/12/19 and are due back to the School Office by 5/3/19. The students will complete their LCAP surveys in their advisories during the month of April. Our annual LCAP meeting is scheduled for 5/23/19, at 6:30pm, in the school gym.

SBAC TESTING: Juniors will be participating in the annual SBAC testing, starting in March. They will be tested in English on March 26th and 27th and again on April 2nd and 3nd. They will be tested in Math on April 30th and May 1st and again on May 7th and 8th. Finally, the Juniors will be tested in Science on May 21st and 22nd.

Sophomores will be tested in Science on May 14th and 15th.
