Overview

This unit is designed to increase the historical cultural and language competency of Spanish level. While expanding your knowledge on how the history of Spain has influenced our cultural understanding of who we are as Latinos, we will work on a **cooking** project where you will be able to see how that historical background is noticeable. You will also continue to have a better grasp of writing, reading, and listening in Spanish. Furthermore, you will boost listening skills through videos, audio, and dictations in Spanish. The goal is to help you to become lifelong learners and users of the foreign language and expand your social dimension by working in pairs and small groups. In addition to independent practice, students will be expected to complete a warm up exercise every morning in class and speak Spanish 100 percent of the time you are in class.

- **Google Translate is not permitted.** You are however, allowed to use an English-Spanish dictionary. You will not get any points for assignments where the use of Google Translate is evident.
- 100% of communication must be in Spanish. The teacher will translate instructions into English when necessary but will also speak 99% in Spanish during class.
- Copying and pasting from any website conjugations of verbs is not allowed. You will automatically receive a zero as a score for the assignment.
