Monitoring Semester Grades

- Friday, January 17th marks the end of the first semester here at Silver Oak High School.
- Please check your student's current grades on PowerSchool and contact his/her advisor with questions/concerns.
- After school tutoring is required of all students who earned less than a C-, in any core subject, the first quarter.
- Tutoring is available, in each core subject, from 4:00 until 4:30pm, every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. The schedule is posted on the bulletin board, outside of the school office.
- Quarter grades may indicate the need for improvement so that semester grades (which appear on the student's permanent transcript) are at a mastery level...C- or higher.

John Fischer and Susan Langer from the Sonoma County SELPA will present on Parents' Rights/Procedural Safeguards, the core parts of an IEP, Accommodations/Modifications, How to Read an IEP and the role of a parent in the IEP process. Group Counseling

We would like to provide an opportunity for your student to participate in small group counseling at school. Small group counseling is designed to assist students with developing awareness of interpersonal issues, to develop strategies and skills to positively impact their school achievement, and to increase appropriate social interaction skills. Being a part of a group is an excellent way for students to learn new skills, develop self-confidence, become more aware of how others see them, practice new behaviors. and better understand how to deal with the many problems that life presents. Some topics that are addressed during group are anxiety management, conflict resolution, self-esteem, assertive communication, and depression management. Participation in the group is completely voluntary.
