How the elements work together, fit together, so the art work looks complete





The Principles of art:

The elements of art; line, shape, texture, color, form, value and space represent the building blocks of art. These are the tools we use when creating art. The **principles** are the **concepts** we use to organize the elements. The principles are what we use as "rules" when

working with the elements. For instance when you are creating your slate project, consider the principles as you put your work together. Consider - Balance - Proportion - Pattern and other elements.
