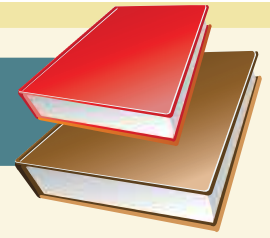
SOHS College Acceptances and College Planning
