Parent Education Night: 2/13/20

All students deserve equal access to unbiased, comprehensive sexual health education. The California Healthy Youth Act was enacted in 2016 requiring public schools to provide this education to all students in middle and high school. *Planned Parenthood Mar Monte*, based here in Hayward, will be providing this required education to our students. All seniors and sophomores will take these hour-long classes, twice per week, for three to four weeks. The freshmen and juniors will have a one hour presentation about "Consent" during advisory period on Wednesday, 2/29/20.
