overview

Spanish 2 is the second level course of the Spanish language and culture. In the first unit of the course we will explore how adolescents use technology to communicate with others and what role technology plays in their lives. In this class, you will use what you have learned so far and

apply it to different real-life situations. This Spanish class instills the idea that learning a foreign language helps us communicate and connect with members of our global community.

You have many choices for completing an activity, practicing a concept from a lesson, and demonstrating knowledge of any lesson given. Most importantly, make sure you ask questions when something is not clear to you.
